Can propane tanks be recycled?

Although propane tanks are made of steel, which is very recyclable, there are very few places that will accept propane tanks because of the possible left over propane left in the tanks. The left over propane can cause explosions and is one of the reasons propane tanks are not accepted at curbside recycling.

As of 2017, propane cylinders are accepted at the Calumet County Hazardous Waste Program through a pilot program between our vendor, Brown County Solid Waste, and Worthington Cylinders. Depending on where you buy a propane tank the original dealer many take the old one. Before purchasing a propane tank make sure the dealer will take the old tanks back for recycling.
